10.00am	Lesson (see below)
Midday	Unsaddle, groom and feed ponies.
12.30pm	LUNCH
2.00pm	Saddle Ponies
2.30pm	Lesson (see below)
3.30pm	Trail ride (weather and safety conditions permitting)
4.30pm	Unsaddle Groom and feed ponies.
5.00pm	Clean gear, wash buckets, tidy barn and yards.
5.30pm	Turn ponies out & recap on day's activities
6.30pm	DINNER
7.00pm	Free time (supervised)
8.00pm	HIT THE SACK!!!

Weekly Lesson Schedule

Monday	AM: Flatwork, safety, position.	PM: Arena Geography, cavaletti
Tuesday	AM: Flatwork, safety, position.	PM: Course building, safety
Wednesday	AM: Showjumping, (theory & Prac)	PM: Jumping position
Thursday	AM: Cavaletti/ground-pole work	PM: Show Equitation and Turnout
Friday	AM: Riding a Dressage Test	PM: Mini One Day Event
